UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK SYSTEMS Class C Operators for Unmanned Facilities

(Class C Operator May Be 2 HOURS Away)

Class C Operator. A Class C operator is the first line of response to events indicating emergency conditions. This person is responsible for responding to alarms or other indications of emergencies caused by spills or releases from underground storage tank systems and equipment failures. A Class C operator must be trained before beginning their duties.

There must be at least one Class C operator on duty at all times when the facility is in operation.
